<p>Addlestone Toy Library £5,550 To cover replacement toy and repackaging costs over 12 months</p>
<p>Ark Club £7,000 To enable them to offer workshops, new activities, a residential for older club members and a daytrip for younger members</p>
<p>Beaver Zoological Gardens & Reptile Rescue Ltd £6,901.89 Teaching skills in Animal Care e.g. Feeding, Cleaning, Repair & Maintenance of Enclosures Where possible teaching Numeracy & Literacy</p>
<p>Bourne CYI £6,114 The project is aimed at engaging young people in Outdoor Education activities, to enable them to set personal challenges and make significant achievements.</p>
<p>Bullies Don't Bite £3,840 special events for their community especially for the children in the fight against bullying</p>
<p>CR3 Youth Project £7,000 The application was made up of many different projects that require funding. (1) Make Good/Improve/Replace. (2) Subsidize additional activities (3) New equipment and additional "in house" facilities</p>
<p>Capel Youth Club £5,035 The youth club will re-open the club on an extra night for a younger feeder group (10-12years) which will enhance the club now and in the future</p>
<p>Chinese Association of Woking £6,812.78 Funding will be used for Chinese Kung Fu with Gymnastic skills. The children will learn self discipline, to focus and be independent-skills that assist self esteem, learning, physical and mental development</p>
<p>Court Community Partnership £7,000 They will set up a Junior Youth Club or "Kids Club" for Primary aged children</p>
<p>Churt Youth Group £2,000 To fund a programme of trips from Churt to local venues of interest to young people</p>
<p>Cranleigh Youth Group £4,787.89 To fund activities including Street Safety, Healthy Eating, Arts, Drug Awareness, Youth Club refurbishment and designing a Youth Club Calendar</p>
<p>Farnham Toy Library £2,740.41 Funding will be used to benefit a more diverse section of the local community, improve current safety equipment and sustain and improve their service.</p>

Most children come from families on low income and would not have the opportunities to go to such activities that the funding will provide</p>
