The Dance Movement £7,000

The activity is called SEED and is a research & development community performance art project uniting 5 community youth groups

Eikon-The Interactive Zone £6,856

Emmanuel Chapel Toddler Group £3,903

The grant will pay for much needed new equipment and a parenting course

Face the Future £7,000

Harvest Mice £1,200

Funding will help establish a toy library and help with group sustainability

The Hatch £7,000

Funding will help improve outdoor facilities which at present are not safe for the children

Hersham Youth Trust £6,943

To meet the expressed needs of local young people by providing a Saturday drop-in and homework club

Home-Start Ash & Guildford £6,001

Funding will support their Family Activity Project, and also to fund continuing professional development fro their staff, trustees and volunteers

Hookwood Playgroup £6,540

Funding will be used to buy replacement items, storage and a new shed

Hubble Community Enterprise £5,320

To expand the existing provision within the local diverse community

Funding will pay for rent, equipment, safety equipment, advertising and insurance

Long Ditton Youth Project £1,560

A grant will pay for rent till April 2008, an outing and more equipment for the club

Lychgate Youth Trust £6,000

Funding will allow the young boys and girls to build the go-karts from scratch to an approved design using top quality materials

Netherne Youth Group £6,651

Funding will provide the children with equipment for varied activities

The Nomads £7,000

Opportunities £4,675

PACT £6,421

PSDS (Down Syndrome) £8,135

A grant would enable them to purchase specialist materials and equipment that otherwise, children might not have access to due to financial limitations

The Studio ADHD Centre £5,112

Series of workshop sessions for children aged 12-16 yrs old, particularly those having Attention Deficit Disorder and related learning difficulties

Tandridge Village Youth £9,427
