Spring Pay Out

42 lucky Surrey based voluntary organisations will be sharing almost a quarter of a million pounds in grants over the next few weeks from the Local Network Fund (LNF).

Voluntary Organisations working with children across Surrey will receive on average £5,500 to help a variety of different activities. These include funding a youth music festival, producing and delivering life improvement courses and a homework club.

LNF Administrator, Graham Phillips and Outreach Worker, Sarah Crabb, based at Surrey Community Action, were delighted so many groups had been successful.

“Fantastic, excellent news” said Tracy Ross of St John’s Pre-School, Merrow, who will use her grant to help buy equipment to fulfil Health and Safety regulations.
